“ALPA Doesn’t Represent My Interests”

Over the years this has been one of the most common complaints I have heard about our MEC, and one of the primary reasons for not participating in the process.

“Why bother, they do what they want any ways....”

Actually they do what they are directed to do – by the **minority of pilots** who actually vote and actively participate in the process.

In the recent Council 44 LEC elections in ATL, only 38% of the pilots voted. This was a record turnout for the ATL elections. I find this astounding - slightly more than 1/3 of the pilots were able to decide for the rest of the pilot group the direction their LEC will take going into the next round of contract negotiations.

It's no surprise some feel ALPA does not represent them – it may not – especially if they did not vote.

Be one of the pilots who helps chart the direction your MEC takes! Please **VOTE**.

I ask for your support and to please vote for [Andrew Massey for C20 S/T, Tom Tucker for CA Rep, and Greg Rizzuto for F/O Rep](#), but more importantly, regardless of who you vote for, learn the issues, the candidates and participate.

I ask for you to be part of transforming ALPA into what is supposed to be – a bottom up, democratic organization, that represents YOU, the average line pilot, not that of a well organized minority with agendas that may not represent your interests !!
